ATTENTION STUDENTS: NEED TUITION MONEY?

The Northwest Chapter of the Indiana Society of Professional Land Surveyors will be awarding two grants of up to **\$1,500** each to help meet the tuition needs of qualified applicants.

Who is eligible? Any student that resides in either Lake, Porter, LaPorte, Newton, Jasper, Pulaski, or Starke County, Indiana, and that is currently enrolled (or planning to enroll) in undergraduate surveying related college level courses is eligible. Grant monies will be awarded preferentially to those students who are pursuing a college education as a means to advance their career in the field of land surveying.

How to apply: Prepare a brief letter expressing interest and containing at a minimum the following:

- 1.) Contact information including address and phone number.
- 2.) College name, school of enrollment, and semester status.
- 3.) Current G.P.A.
- 4.) Course names and numbers for which grant monies are requested.
- 5.) Any extenuating circumstances such as unusual financial need, scholastic honors, or career objective that may influence the committee in awarding a grant.
