Steve,

About nine of us got together before the convention to discuss the Stormwater Ordinance, so we would like to get together with you and Dave from CBBEL. Let me know if the February Drainage Board day will work and I'll coordinate something with a few of those that were at the meeting that are interested.

Basically the issues we would like to discuss are as follows:

- (1) Modeling of emergency routing from ponds and related downstream impacts
- (2) TSS removal rates of some of the BMPs, but especially wet ponds (making it 80%)
- (3) Issues related to modeling of TSS removal efficiencies
- (4) Interpretation of pad elevations with respect to overflow route when the 100-year condition has already been modeled.
- (5) Possibility of substituting finish floor elevation instead of pad elevation for minimum elevation separation from overflow route.
- (6) Clarifying the table of release rates so it's known what the rates are based on and when variances may be appropriate.

I think that covers most of the issues that we discussed. If we get organized and have enough time, we will send a little more detail on our concerns with these issues and some possible solutions prior to the meeting. If not, then we can just discuss in detail at the meeting.
